Guidelines for Setting Rules that Work



- 1. Decide upon a few important rules.
- 2. Discuss the rationale for these rules with your children.
- 3. Discuss with your children the limits of the rules, reasonable rewards for following them, and fair consequences for breaking them.
- 4. Praise your children when they follow the rules.
- 5. Consistently, assertively, and calmly follow through with the consequences when the rules are broken.
- 6. Change the rules and expectations as your children grow up.
